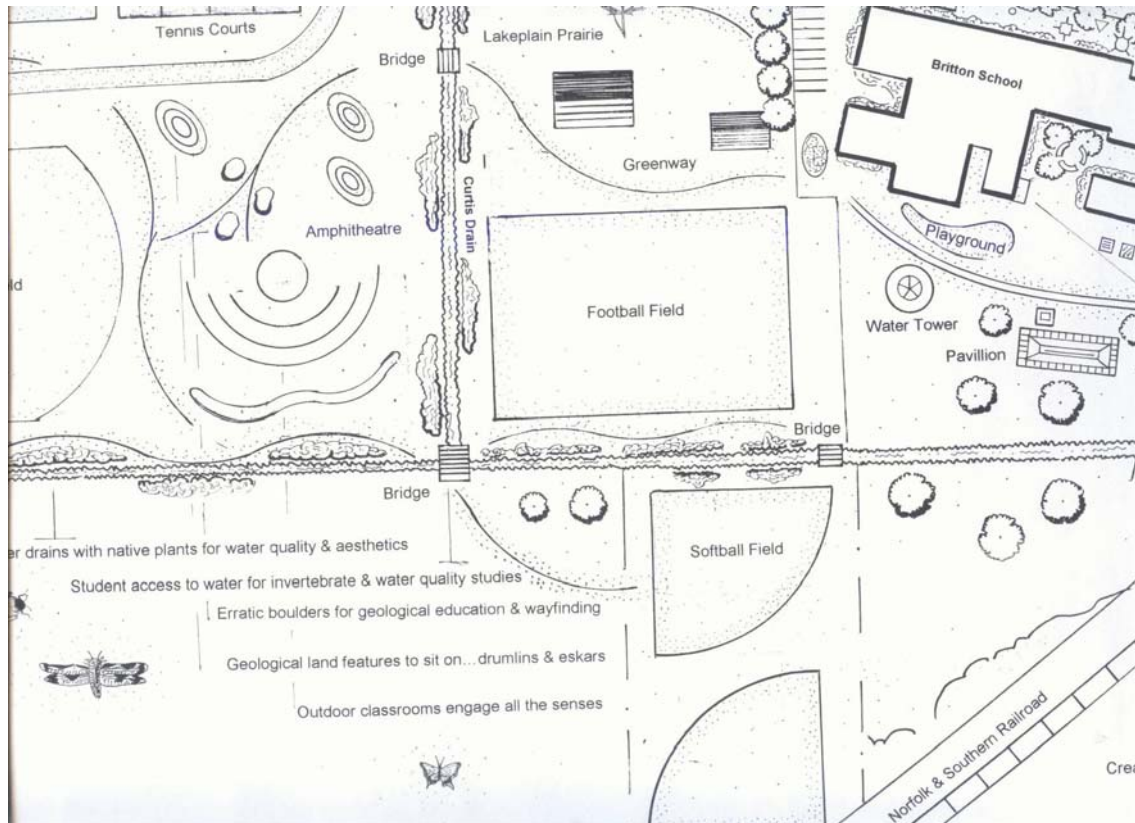


Britton-Macon School System

Landscapes for Learning



A concept plan was created for Britton-Macon School System. Ecological educational landscapes were developed using natural landscape design, outdoor classroom development, rain gardens, and native Michigan habitats for the Britton-Macon Area School. This provides on-site storm water treatment, reduced maintenance, and management that will give students hands-on experience. These landscape elements e.g. rain gardens perform necessary functions to maintain water quality.

The project is in the concept phase. Nativescape is researching funding sources for construction plan development for the individual landscape elements. This can be a step by step approach to implementing the Landscapes for Learning Plan with budget cuts in our school systems.
